**The state of Ohio has created an incentive program to promote the hiring of high school interns. The Ohio Career Exploration Internship Program will reimburse for-profit companies %50 of the wages paid to interns up to \$5,000. A company is able to provide this opportunity to three interns in one calendar year. To be eligible for reimbursement the intern must work for at least 20 weeks and 200 hours.
